

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CARE GROUP SUMMARY

Have you ever felt distant from the Lord or wondered how to experience greater intimacy with Him beyond simply going through the motions?

In this Care Group, we will explore what it truly means to draw near to Jesus in worship—not out of obligation, but from a real and personal relationship with Him.

KEY POINTS

1. The veil is torn—you have full and unrestricted access to His presence.

"... having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He consecrated for us ... let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water." —Hebrews 10:19–22

Now you can draw near to the Lord in a new and living way—not by striving, but by resting in His finished work. Worship becomes a response to His love, not a requirement to earn it.

2. Worship under the new covenant flows from intimacy, not obligation.

"Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need." —Hebrews 4:16

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In the old covenant, God warned Moses that no one could approach His presence at any time—only the high priest, only once a year, and only with blood (Leviticus 16:2). There was distance, caution, and fear.

But under the new covenant, Jesus has torn the veil and forever changed how we approach Him. Now, we're invited to come boldly—not with fear, but with full assurance of His love.

We don't worship to get close—we worship because Jesus has already brought us close.

3. In worship, we draw near to Jesus, encounter His love, experience His power, and see breakthroughs begin.

You can't be in His presence and not encounter His power. His presence brings peace and transformation. His power works not only in outward circumstances but also in the hidden places of your heart—healing what's broken and mending what you may not even realize is hurting. In worship, breakthrough often begins from within, and from there, it affects every aspect of your life.

OWN THE WORD

- 1. Have you ever experienced a moment of breakthrough or healing during worship? Are there areas in your life where you need Jesus' power to bring healing or change?
- 2. How does knowing that you are already close to Jesus—because of His finished work on the cross—change the way you worship?
- 3. Take some time this week to simply worship Jesus—without any agenda, just enjoy His presence.
